1. **Partner in Pet Food Hungária Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság** (registered seat: 1112 Budapest, Boldizsár utca 4.; company registration No: Cg. 01-09-427202; e-mail: info@ppfeurope.com; telephone: +36 1 801 02 03) ("Company") is using cookies in certain areas of <http://www.ppfeurope.com/>. Cookies are files that store information on the users' web browser. This Cookie Policy („Policy”) provides information on the use of cookies.
2. Cookies, for example, allow the website to recognise the user when a user has visited the site earlier, or help identify which part of the site is the most popular, which parts the users are visiting, and for how long they stay there. By analysing this kind of information, the Company can adjust the website to the needs of users and can provide a more diverse users experience. By the help of cookies, the Company can also ensure that the information that is displayed on a user's next visit will meet the users' expectations.

The Company reserves the right to modify this Policy unilaterally with effect subsequent to such modification, subject to the limitations provided for in the laws and with advance notification to the Applicants in due time, if necessary. The Company may modify this Policy especially when it is required upon changes in the laws, the practice of the data protection authority, business needs or employees' needs or any newly revealed security exposures. Upon request, the Company will send a copy of the latest updated version of this Policy to individuals.
4. Our site allows the user to agree or disagree to the use of certain cookie sets (see Clause 7). At their first visit of the site and then at regular intervals, users are asked to consent to the use of cookies. Users can change their choice at any time by clicking on the "Cookie Settings" link at the bottom of the page. The website <http://www.ppfeurope.com/> is designed to operate with cookies, whereby disabling them may affect the usability of the website or prevent the user from taking full advantage of it.
5. The users can configure their web browser to accept all cookies, reject all cookies, or notify the user when a cookie is sent to the user's computer. Each web search is different so the „Help" menu in the search engine can help users change cookie settings. Contains a random generated number as its value (e.g., GA1.2.255322818.1517541613). It allows us to make statistics about user visits to the site during the past 24 months. A Examples of the data collected: unique IDs, browser types and settings, device types and settings, operating systems. _gid	Statistical cookie – enabled by default, and the user can enable or disable it at any time A cookie used by Google (third party cookie).	It is similar to the _ga cookie. It is used to distinguish users anonymously, allowing Google Analytics to measure visitors’ usage habits on the website.	24 hours
Youtube cookies	Convenience cookie – enabled by default, and the user can enable or disable it at any time A cookie used by Google (third party cookie).	We embed videos from our own official Youtube channel in the site in the so-called privacy-enhanced mode. These embedded videos do not appear, unless you accept the convenience cookies. In this case, Youtube leaves some cookies on the user's device which the service provider cannot control. These cookies do not allow personal identification of the user.
